

**ELECTRIC SERVICE
SCHEDULES R-107
RESIDENTIAL/FARM SERVICE**

Availability & Applicability

These schedules are available and applicable for residential and farm uses as defined in General Terms & Conditions.

All service under these schedules shall be single-phase, delivered through a single set of service wires, the service location to be designated by the Cooperative. Service shall be at a nominal potential of 120/240 volts, 3-wire or at the sole option of the Cooperative, 120 volts, 2-wire service may be furnished.

The size of individual motors shall not exceed 15 HP nameplate rating except where written permission is granted by the Cooperative. Cooperative reserves the right to require that all motors 10 HP and larger shall be equipped with reduced Voltage starting equipment so as to avoid unnecessary Voltage surges on the Cooperative's system.

The Cooperative also reserves the right to install demand metering where required transformer capacity exceeds 25kVA.

Net Rate per Month or Part Thereof

Billing shall be the sum of the charges under the applicable rate set forth below.

- (a) Rate R-107, applicable to residential customers with an uncontrolled water heater.

Service Charge: \$18.00

- (b) Rate R-207, applicable to residential customers with an uncontrolled water heater on Kelleys Island:

Service Charge: \$18.00

Distribution Delivery Service

Energy Charge:

First 300 kWh's @	10.5 c/kWh
Next 700 kWh's @	8.2 c/kWh
Over 1,000 kWh's @	7.5 c/kWh

Plus Wholesale Power & Transmission Delivery Charge:

Radio Control Switch:

Water Heater \$1.50 (credit)

Central Air Conditioning \$1.50 (credit)

When Cooperative elects to install a demand meter, a \$2.00 per kW billing demand charge is applied to residential consumers with a transformer capacity in excess of 25 kVA.

Monthly Minimum Charge

The monthly minimum charge per consumer, before adjustments, shall be not less than the higher amount as determined under either (a) or (b) below:

- (a) BASE RATE MINIMUM CHARGE
Service Charge

- (b) MINIMUM CHARGE WHEN BASED ON INSTALLED OR ALLOCATED TRANSFORMER CAPACITY
\$3.00 per kVA in excess of 25 kVA of transformer capacity
Plus the applicable minimum under (a) above.

Adjustments to Rates and Charges

The foregoing rates and charges shall be subject to increase or decrease to the extent that the provisions and adjustments apply as is specified elsewhere under Rider "B", Purchased Wholesale Power, Transmission Delivery & Tax Cost Adjustment.

Duration of Minimum Charge

The minimum charge as determined above shall be applied monthly following the date service is initially established. The property owner shall be responsible for this minimum charge each month.

All Service connection and disconnection is subject to an applicable trip charge as provided in Miscellaneous Service Charges of General Terms & Conditions.

Terms of Payment

The above rates and other applicable charges are net as shown. Any account not paid on or before the final payment date shall be subject to an applicable service charge as per the General Terms & Conditions of Service.

If any bill is not paid within 30 days after the payment date specified on the bill, service will be subject to disconnection as provided in Cooperative's General Terms & Conditions and any reconnection of service shall be subject to Cooperative's charge for such special service.

Budgeted Terms of Payment

Upon the request of the consumer, and upon the approval of the Cooperative, a budget plan for payment of electric bills may be elected by the consumer.

Other Terms and Conditions

(1) Responsibility for Payment of Bills

Where the premises are occupied by a tenant, Cooperative reserves the right to require the property owner to apply for service in his name and he shall be responsible for payment of all bills. In such event, the bill may be mailed to the tenant, with a copy to the property owner. Although a tenant may be required to make a deposit to secure bill payment, such deposit shall not relieve property owner of his responsibility for payment of bills.

(2) Temporary Service

Cooperative reserves the right to require that any application for temporary service be in the name of the property owner, who shall pay all electric service bills.

(3) Use of Service

Service under this schedule shall not be resold or shared with others, except as provided in General Terms and Conditions.
